1.	The student creates dramatic works
35%	<ul style="list-style-type: none"> -The student applies ideas for the creation of a dramatic work. -The student uses elements of dramatic language. -The student organizes her dramatic creation. -The student presents her dramatic creation. -The student shares her dramatic creation experience.
<i>Activity types in this competency: writes scenes, skits, plans movement / voice pieces / tableau, gives and receives feedback (from peers and teacher)</i>	
2.	The student performs dramatic works
35%	<ul style="list-style-type: none"> -The student becomes familiar with the dramatic content of the work. -The student uses elements of dramatic language. -The student becomes familiar with the expressive nature of the work. -The student respects the conventions regarding unified performance. -The student shares her performance experience.
<i>Activity types in this competency: uses improvisation, performs self-created work, as well as scripted work, shares her experience of the process and the final product</i>	
3.	The student appreciates dramatic works
30%	<ul style="list-style-type: none"> -The student analyzes a dramatic work. -The student interprets the meaning of the work. -The student makes critical and aesthetic judgments. -The student shares her appreciation experience.
<i>Activity types in this competency: learns to critique performances, looks at different dramatic works, explores different genres of plays, discusses her choices, preferences, and observations.</i>
